- Two noon hour supervisors hired, Ki, just lunch hour, Liana, both just started today, still have one more opening
  - Resume and first aid required, first aid provided, it is a paid position
- "I Ride", further details from Andrew
- Soccer has started for grade % students, with Mr Blackmore and Mrs Ball
- Cross Country has started, notice to be sent home

#### 2. Upcoming events/notices:

- 29 people have used the online
- Number of changes
  - Monthly deadlines
  - Lots of reminders going out
  - o Pizza is the first one, treats not offered this year
  - o Prices are staying the same
  - Not doing Sushi this year, in spite of complaints
    - Done to simplify
  - Noodle box will deliver, have to take bins back
  - o If Kids need lunch covered, cammy will let us know via teachers
  - o PAC can't have access to online payment, teacher to set up
    - More limited than outlunch.net website
    - Also pay paypal fees
  - New district donation website started up this year
    - Waiting for setup and kinks to be worked out
    - Waiting to implement when ready
  - We still make a lot of money through hot lunch program
    - It still makes sense in spite of fees
    - Easier and more direct with funds
    - A lot of questions yet to answer regarding how it would work to get money out of district online method
